The minutes from the last meeting were read and approved.

We discussed the nominating committee. Bob Dean, Wilbur Thomas, Mary Griffith, Bruce Beck and Leon Webster are willing to continue on the board. Margaret is undecided and John would prefer to just be the schedule master. Margaret Kelly and Mary Burbank and Chuck Sunder were named by the board to the nominating committee.

We discussed some problems with the schedule as it appeared in the newsletter. John Miller re-did it --- Bruce Beck mailed copies to ride leaders. The corrected schedule also appears on the web-site.

The Annual Meeting will be Sunday, October 29th at Crossview Lutheran Church in Edina. There will also be two rides 26 & 37. The deadline for the dinner will be 10/21 /00. There is no deadline for attending the meeting. February 25, 2001 will be the Awards Banquet.
